The Training Environment

- No diver is permitted to be in the dryland area unless under direct supervision of a coach.
- No coach is permitted to be in the dryland area on their own with only 1 diver.
- No coach is permitted to coach only 1 diver at the MLC venue.
- No coach is permitted to transport only 1 diver in a vehicle.
- No food or drink at all is allowed in the dryland area by anyone
- No gym or other bags are allowed in the dryland area - they can be stored in the area outside the toilet, against the wall or on the benches.
- Divers are to be encouraged to remove all belongings and anything else they brought with them when leaving.
- No parents, carers or spectators are allowed in the dryland area, unless they have business in the RDC office.
- No parents are to sit on the benches on the park side of the diving well. That area is a workplace safety area and we need to keep it free of distractions for coaches as well as divers. Parents may sit in the stands, on the benches on the stand side or next to the 50m pool.
- The RDC office is for use by RDC staff and Board Members only.
- All divers must be registered online prior to attending a class
- We do not take any responsibility at all for any personal items left anywhere in dryland or on pool deck.
- No jewellery or watches that can scrape, get stuck or broken are to be worn in any training environment
- Appropriate and safe clothing for hand spotting needs to be worn in Dryland. E.g. Shorts and t-shirt/singlet. Dry bathers can be worn underneath
- Tuition fees do not include access to some venues. Aquanation and MSAC require an entry fee for all divers over and above tuition fees. These are paid at the front desk. Membership options are available for Full RDC members- see Aquanation staff for details. In some venues spectator fees may be payable.

I understand and agree that I must pay pool entry at Aquanation and MSAC, and that those fees are not included in the price paid here. Aquanation determines cost for members of RDC. 10-session passes and membership options are available from the Aquanation staff

I understand and agree that in most instances, refunds or make-up classes will only be offered upon presentation of a medical certificate. Please see our make-up policy.

I understand that parents are not allowed on the pool deck near the dive boards.

I recognise that participation in physical activities carries with it a reasonable assumption of risk. In the event of injury or illness, I authorise the person in charge to administer first aid and to seek further medical, hospital or ambulance treatment if required. I agree to pay any costs incurred.

I agree to provide Ringwood Diving Club with information regarding any medical, physical or behavioural conditions or issues that may affect participation, including a management plan if applicable. Our coaches are committed to helping each child have an enjoyable and successful experience and the more information they have the better they are able to assist.

Group and individual publicity and training photos and videos may be taken from time to time. I consent to my child's unnamed image being used in promotional and training material.
